YES - We have rooms (limited availability) which include double, triple, quad or dorm rooms. These must be booked in advance due to limited availability.

**WILL THERE BE A LOCKOUT?**

YES - A 12am lockout curfew will be in place. There are no exceptions to this.

**IS THERE PASS OUTS THROUGHOUT THE DAY?**

YES - Pass outs are available throughout the day, please note that if you are wanting to return to the venue late it is advised to arrive prior to 11pm to avoid being locked out at midnight if there is a line up.

### **CAN I BRING ALCOHOL, FOOD OR OTHER BEVERAGES?**

NO - We are a fully licensed venue. Food will be always available from our bistro.

### **IS THERE PARKING CLOSE TO THE FESTIVAL?**

YES - Some limited parking will be available on site (get in quick).  
However, on-street parking close by.

### **WILL I BE ABLE TO CHARGE MY PHONE?**

YES - Limited phone charging is available via phone charging station.  
Please charge your phone at home before festival to avoid disappointment.

### **IS TIDAL SOUNDS MUSIC FESTIVAL ALL AGES?**

NO - WE ARE AN 18+ ONLY EVENT!

### **ARE PEOPLE UNDER 18 ALLOWED INTO BARS OR LICENSED AREAS?**

NO - Most definitely not. Any Minors found in these areas will be evicted from TIDAL SOUNDS and may face prosecution. This includes Minors in the company of responsible adults – those aged under 18 cannot enter festival grounds.

### **WHAT IF I LOSE MY ID BEFORE THE FESTIVAL?**

Please have your ID replaced ASAP as you must have valid ID to enter the festival. This isn't just a ticketing requirement, it's a legal requirement. Even with a valid ticket, you will not be admitted without ID.

### **ACCESSIBILITY:**

Holders of a National or State issued Companion Card may request a Companion Ticket equivalent to the ticket type held by the person with a disability.

Upon approval of request, Tidal Sounds Music Festival will issue companions a complimentary Ticket to the Event to accompany a person with disability.

### **ACCESSIBILITY - Companion Card ticket request requirements:**

- Name, email and mobile number for Companion Card holder requesting a Companion Card ticket
- A copy of your valid Tidal Sounds Music Festival Ticket/s, displaying your name, DOB and ticket number
  - A scanned copy of the valid Companion Card being used
    - Name, email and DOB of the carer

***The complimentary Companion Card ticket will be issued via email direct to the carer.***

### **BANNED ITEMS THAT ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE EVENT AREA:**

- Bags larger than an A4 piece of paper – 30cm x 20cm
- Illegal drugs and drug paraphernalia • Alcohol brought in from outside of the event.
  - Glass of any kind • Weapons of any kind • Water pistols • Skateboards
- Culturally sensitive items and attire • Anything studded (i.e. belts, wristbands etc)
  - Clothing, jewellery, or accessory displaying the name of any motorcycle-related, gang or similar organisations or any “declared organisation” within the meaning of the Crimes (Criminal Organisation Control) Act 2009 is not permitted.
- Strictly no animals (with the exception of service or assistance animals, such as guide dogs) • Any other items considered illegal or dangerous.
